

# Headlines Tennis court troubles Let your voice be heard in the neighborhood survey Deadline for cutting grass on vacant lots

- Recent activity at our neighborhood tennis/basketball complex has created the need for additional security measures. The board is considering several possibilities including installation of a locked gate to block access to the parking lot. The board believes the problem is limited to people who do not live in the neighborhood, yet trespass on the property to use the courts. Recently, homeowners visiting the complex have noticed groups of teens using foul and intimidating language around families with young children and littering, leaving behind broken glass bottles and, in one instance, a broken glass pipe that was likely used for illegal drugs. As the board works to address the problem, we request your assistance by asking that homeowners not share the gate code with people who do not live in the neighborhood. When leaving the complex, please dispose of your trash properly and ensure that the doors to the complex are closed. Thank you in advance for your help in managing this neighborhood asset. We want to make sure that the sports complex continues to be a place where homeowners can feel safe while enjoying summer activities.
